I. GENERAL OBLIGATIONS

The license holder shall:

- 1. Comply with the Organic Law N° 04/2005 of 08/04/2005 determining the modalities of protection, conservation and promotion of environment in Rwanda;
- 2. Comply with the Law N° 85/2013 of 11/9/2013 regulating Petroleum and Petroleum Products Trade in Rwanda and any other subsidiary legislation regulations issued there under;
- 3. Comply with the regulation N° 08/R/GP-EWS/RURA/2023 of 24/02/2023 governing the installation, upgrade and operation of Petrol Service Stations in Rwanda;
- 4. Abide by the adopted Rwandan Standards relating to downstream petroleum industry;
- 5. Exhibit such license at all times in his or her usual place of business as evidence that he/she is authorized to carry out the intended retail activity;
- 6. Comply with all monitoring, reporting requirements and enforcement actions imposed by RURA;
- 7. Not transfer the license to a third party unless such transfer is approved by RURA.

II. SPECIFIC OBLIGATION

- 1. Test fuel storage tanks, piping system, dispensers and safety equipment;
- 2. Train personnel on safety, dispensing operations and spill management plan in place;
- 3. Carry out a regular leak detection and maintenance of the tanks and their accessories on 2 years' basis;
- 4. Off-load and sell standard petroleum products;
- 5. Report to RURA all major leaks and spillages;
- 6. Comply with all provisions of the regulations related to operation of Petrol service stations;
- 7.Comply with the approved roadmap for upgrade of this licensed Petrol service station, where applicable.
