I. <u>GENERAL OBLIGATIONS:</u>

The licensee shall:

- 1. Comply with applicable laws, guidelines and regulations;
- 2. Maintain all technical, financial and accounting records and submit annual reports to RURA combining administrative, financial and technical issues of the business progress. RURA reserves the rights to request any report at any given time when necessary;
- 3. Comply with all monitoring, inspection and reporting requirements imposed by RURA;
- 4. Provide requested information during inspections. This license must be presented to the staff in charge of control and inspections when demanded;
- 5. Not abandon, change or extend activities authorized under this license without prior approval of RURA.

II. <u>SPECIFIC OBLIGATIONS</u>:

- Do not fill and sell LPG in cylinders to a wholesaler or retailer;
- Ensure that pipes and gas flow meters to be used have been tested and re-validated in accordance with relevant standards on the required time;
- Conduct a fire safety assessment of the LPG reticulation at least twice a year;
- Only use pipes and gas flow meters that conform to National Standard;
- Ensure that all gas flow meters have been calibrated to ensure delivery of accurate net weights;
- Provide the sample of LPG to the competent authority for standard compliance verification when deemed necessary.
- Maintain 10 days minimum operational stocks
- Submit quarterly sales data.
- Comply with any other obligations set by the Regulatory Authority

N.B: This license is valid for five (5) years renewable.
