Pursuant to Law N°24/2016 of 18/06/2016 governing Information and Communication Technologies especially in Article 130 (6°);

Pursuant to Law n°48/2018 of 13/08/2018 on Environment protection

Pursuant to Regulation n°002 of 26/4/2018 governing e-waste management in Rwanda;

Hereby issue E- Waste Dismantling and Refurbishment license:

# **OBLIGATIONS OF THE LICENSEE**

# A. GENERAL OBLIGATIONS:

#### The licensee must:

- 1. Comply with relevant environment law and other applicable laws, regulations, guidelines and quality standards regulations;
- 2. Establish and comply with the code of ethics applicable to its employee in order to ensure their safety;
- 3. Maintain all technical, financial and accounting records and submit a quarterly report to RURA combining administrative, financial and technical issues of the business progress. RURA reserves the rights to request any report at any given time when necessary;
- 4. Not abandon, change or extend activities authorized under this license without prior approval of RURA and;
- **5.** Pay the annual fees payable by all regulated public utilities as determined by relevant regulations.

# **B. SPECIFIC OBLIGATIONS:**

### The licensee must:

- 1. Ensure that e- waste containers are available, operational and clearly labeled to indicate the presence of e- waste during Dismantling and Refurbishment;
- 2. Ensure adequate equipment for Dismantling and Refurbishment as specified in e-waste standards;
- 3. Ensure segregation at source of e-waste with other types of solid waste and handled separately in accordance with standards;
- 4. Provide the employees with adequate protective equipments and insurances as stipulated in the regulations;
- 5. Avoid polluting the environment including soil, surface and underground water as well as air;

NB: This License is valid for 5 years.
