- 4. Exhibit this license at all times on your construction site as evidence that you are authorized to carry out installation LPG plant activities
- 5. Comply with all monitoring and reporting requirements and enforcement actions imposed by RURA
- 6. Do not transfer this license to a third party unless such transfer is approved by RURA

II. <u>SPECIFIC OBLIGATIONS</u>:

- Provide conditions at workplace that promote health and safety standards;
- Take appropriate measures to avoid or minimize risks by employing a structured program of risk management;
- Ensure that your installation and construction materials comply with national standards and used according to their technical specifications;
